# The BBC and India

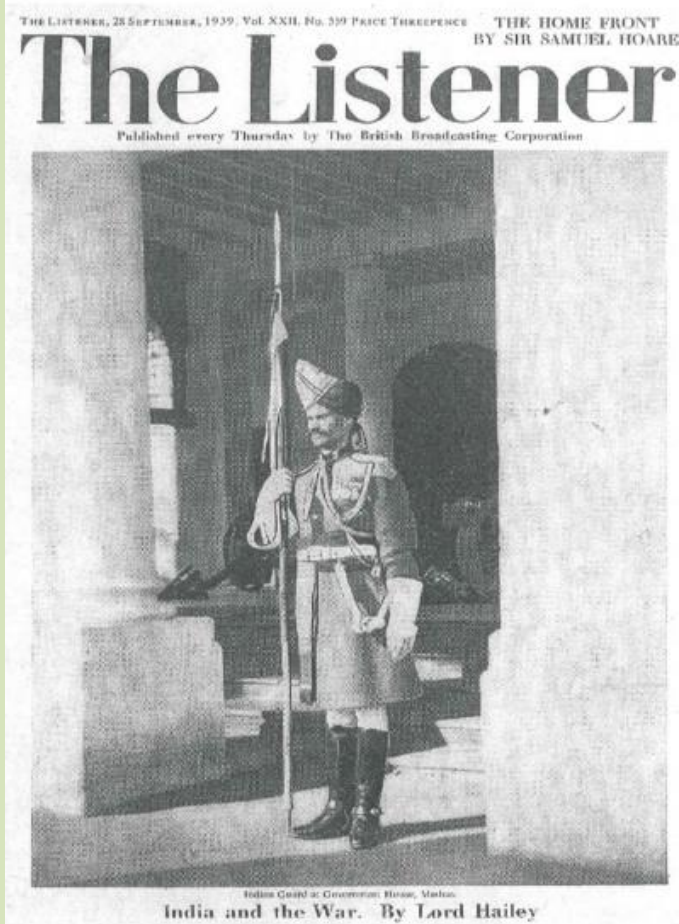
